



Year 1 - Week Commencing 16.10.20

English

Last week we looked at acrostic poems about Autumn. We read a variety of acrostic poems, including poems about Autumn. We also gathered a word bank of new Autumn words and phrases that we can use when writing our poem. This week we will be continuing with this topic and will begin to write our own Autumn acrostic poem! We will be continuing with our grammar focus of finger spaces and using our robot arms to spell out words.

Phonics

We will be looking at the sounds: ng ai ee.

If you want to practise these sounds at home, type in 'Geraldine Giraffe' into youtube followed by the sound that you want to practise. We watch Geraldine in class and the children love it!

We will have some of these sounds in our spellings to practise this week.

Maths

Last week we looked at using the part-part whole method with the addition symbol. We practised adding numbers together and using resources to help us. This week we are continuing to look at adding together and will be focusing a heavily on number bonds to 10 and different strategies that we can use to add together up to 10.

Topic

Last week we started our first Geography lesson about places in the United Kingdom. We looked at the United Kingdom and found it on the map. We shared our homework together and explore England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales. This week we will be continuing with Geography and looking at physical features of the UK, including using words such as: mountains, beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, sea, ocean, river, soil, and valley. We will be labelling these words and matching them with the correct pictures.

Home Learning

For the homework this week, children are applying what they have learnt in Maths and looking at adding together 2 numbers up to 10. This is a double sided sheet so please look at the questions on the back too. For their spellings I have included new words linking to their phonics and new 'tricky' words that must be learnt by sight and not sounding out. I will send half-terms homework next Friday the 23rd.
