

## Year 2 - Week Commencing 19.10.20

### Maths

We will be looking at which appropriate equipment to use when measuring length and height and investigating how to use rulers to measure length/height to the nearest cm. We will be learning to use cm and m to measure length/height and comparing and ordering lengths.

### English

This week we will be planning a non-chronological report about Barnoldswick. We will then use our shared text map and our plans to begin writing our own non-chronological reports about Barnoldswick. We will be writing short descriptions and will be focusing on applying skills such as conjunctions, adjectives, full stops, capital letters and question marks.

### Theme

This week in history, we will be looking at the differences between the past and the present and being able to recognise how life now is different from the life of someone in the past. In PSHE we will be learning about Black History as October is Black History Month

**There are also the lists of High Frequency words in the front of your child's reading record book that need to be practised. Please note that these do not need to be learned all at once-just select a few to focus on each week.**

### Phonics/ spelling Focus:

This week we will focus on the graphemes ie, i-e and igh (as in bike, pie and night) and also the /er/ sound (as in sister and stir).

Mrs Ashley's group will be focusing on the /igh/ sound.
