English

This week we have been looking at a variety of firework poems! We have been reading the poems together and discussing them as a class and picking out the words that we like. We then created a word bank using these words. We also looked at using the suffix -ed. This week we are writing our firework poems and thinking about handwriting, finger spaces, segmenting words (spellings) and using the suffix -ed.
