English

This week we will be looking at fire poems. We will be reading through a variety of poems all about fire and bonfires and will be creating a word bank that we can use to write our poems next week. We will also be focusing on the suffix -ed and adding it to words to change their spelling,

Phonics

We will be looking at the sounds: oo (long and short) oa.

Children have already done some of Phase 3 in Class R but we will be recapping this Phase as we need to be secure on this before moving on. If you want to practise these sounds at home, type in 'Geraldine Giraffe' into youtube followed by the sound that you want to practise. We watch Geraldine in class and the children love it!

Maths

We will be continuing to add and subtract numbers up to 10. We will be using the part-whole method and number lines to master addition and subtraction. This week we will be looking at subtraction and how we can take away and find the difference.

Topic

We will be moving onto our new topic of 'The Great Fire of London'. From past experience, this topic becomes pupil's favourite as they love learning about the past and the gory details. This week we will be locating London on a map and talking about the famous landmarks of London.
