Maths

This week we will be looking at the following objectives:

- To use the column method to subtract a two digit number from a three digit number crossing 10.
- To use the column to subtract a two digit number from a three digit number crossing 10 and 100.
- To use the column method to subtract a three digit number from a three digit number.
- To subtract a three digit number from a three digit number. Reasoning focus.

English Unit

We will be continuing our non-fiction unit based on writing a tour guide to London. The children will be finishing their tour guide writing that we have been working on together and following this, they will be completing an independent write based on different landmarks in London.

During shared writing, we will be focusing on including Year 3 common exception words, using the determiners 'a' or 'an' correctly and a range of conjunctions. The children will then complete their independent writing, aiming to include the elements that we have been working on throughout this unit.

On Monday afternoon we will have PE, therefore the children need to come to school dressed in their PE kits. Please note that we will always aim to do PE outside where possible.

In PSHE we are looking at identifying healthy and unhealthy choices and that the choices that people make in daily life could affect their health.

In Science this week we will be looking at classifying foods into those that are high or low in particular nutrients and planning a daily diet to contain a good balance of nutrients.

Mrs Harper will be teaching RE based on Islam, and Art and DT linked to food and healthy eating. In art the children will be looking at Giuseppe Arcimboldo and in DT Clays Oldenburg sculptures. In English, the children will be looking at the features of biographies and in maths telling the time to the nearest five minutes.

Spelling: /au/ sound spelt 'a' before 'l' and 'll' /au/ sound spelt 'ar' after 'w'
