Maths

This week we will be looking at the following objectives:

- To add and subtract 2 and 3 digit numbers not crossing 100. Reasoning focus.
- To add two and three digit numbers crossing 100.
- To subtract a two digit number from a three digit number crossing 100.
- To identify patterns when adding and subtracting a two and three digit number.

English Unit

We will be starting a non-fiction unit. Following on from Paddington Bear, this will be all about London. The children will be learning all about the landmarks in London and writing their own tour guide for Paddington. This week we will be working on the following objectives:

- To identify some London landmarks, make links and record simple facts.
- To read short bursts of information and recall key facts.
- To use point and evidence to sort statements into true and false.
- To respond orally and in writing to retrieval questions.

On Monday afternoon we will have PE, therefore the children need to come to school dressed in their PE kits. Please note that we will always aim to do PE outside where possible.

In Science we will be looking at shadows, identifying that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object. We will be investigating the shadows that are created when shining a torch on different materials.

In PSHE we will be looking at different scenarios and how our feelings could influence the way we react. We will be looking at who can help us with our feelings and emotions in different situations.

On Wednesday afternoon the children will be looking at locating landmarks in London using a variety of maps and on Thursday afternoon they will be completing a variety of activities linked to Bonfire night.
