

## Year 6 - Week Commencing 16th November 2020

### Maths

This week we will continue our work on fractions – the children are working so hard to understand this! Our objectives are:

- To compare and order fractions with the same numerator.
- To be able to add fractions.
- To be able to add fractions with a result greater than 1
- To be able to add mixed numbers and improper fractions

### English

We will be continuing our unit of work this week based on biographies. We will be exploring the features and content of a biography and using this knowledge to write a biography of their own. This week's objectives are:

- To select appropriate vocabulary for precision and impact.
- To retrieve, record, make notes and present information from non-fiction.
- To demonstrate active reading strategies and generate challenging questions.
- To use known features to write a biography.

### Theme

This week we will be continuing units of work for Art and Music. In Art we will be studying the artist Wassily Kandinsky and producing our own pieces of art in his style. In Music we will be looking at the work of Benjamin Britten and other pieces of music of the era.

The children will also be continuing our Science unit of work on Light with Mrs Harper as well as continuing their weekly PSHE lessons with Marie.
