

Year 6 - Week Commencing 2nd November 2020

Maths

This week we will be looking at the following:

To be able to simplify fractions

To be able to place fractions on a number line

To be able to compare and order fractions with the same and different denominators

To compare and order fractions with the same numerator

English

We will be beginning a new unit of work this week based on biographies. We will be exploring the features and content of a biography and using this knowledge to write the introduction to a biography. We will be exploring the vocabulary used in the writing of a biography and including this in the ones we write during the week.

On Thursday the children will also have a creative writing afternoon where they can enjoy their writing and have the freedom to be as adventurous as they wish.

Theme

This week we will begin our new unit of work for Art and Music. In Art we will be studying the artist Wassily Kandinsky and producing our own pieces of art in his style. In Music we will be looking at the work of Benjamin Britten and other pieces of music of the era.
