Art - Textiles

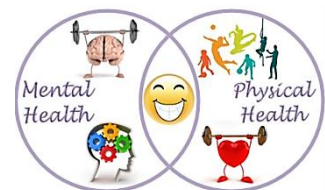
Music - Charanga unit - Phil Harrison
