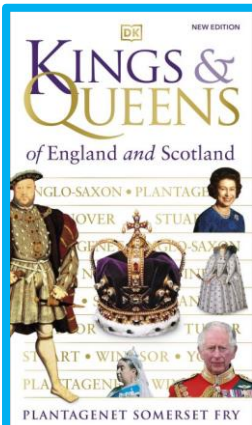
Welcome to our first term together here

History – Kings and Queens of England

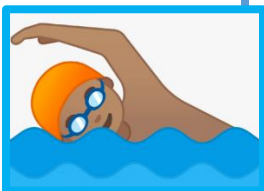
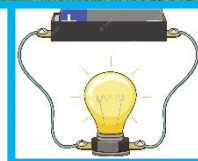
Design Technology – Torches

Homework

In Class 4, the weekly homework consists of Reading, Times Tables, TTRockstars, Spellings and Active Learn.

Reading: Every evening using their Home Reader with Reading Record, to be signed by parents. Reading Records will be checked daily by Mrs Carter.

Times Tables: Each week you child will be given a list of Times Tables to practice/learn. We will have a test on a Friday each week (starting 15.9.23).

TTRockstars: 10 minutes per week.

Spellings: I will give the children a short list of words to learn each week. We will not be having formal tests on these words, but I will be assessing the children's ability to apply these words correctly as part of their English Writing assessment, so it is important that they practice each week. I will also send an email with a variety of spelling activities that the children can do to make learning these words more fun 😊.

Active Learn: At least once per week (can be done in place of Home Reader book)
