English

This half term we will be looking the book 'The Way Home for Wolf' by Sarah Bright. We will be writing our own story based on this book!

Our **Key Learning** will be:

- Secure the use of full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks and question marks.
- Say, write and punctuation sentences using *and*, *but* and *or*.
- Collect new vocabulary and key words.
- Use past tense for narratives.
- Proof read to check for errors.



We will also be looking at non-fiction text and will be creating an information page about wolves.

. Our **Key Learning** will be:

- Secure the use of full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks and question marks.
- Use commas to separate items in a list.
- Say, write and punctuation sentences using *and*, *but* and *or*.
- Use adjectives effectively to create expanded noun phrases (e.g. the blue butterfly with shimmering wings.)

Our artist for this half term is L. S. Lowry! We will be investigating his use of colour, secondary colours and the colour wheel. We will be creating a landscape in his style, which uses printing!

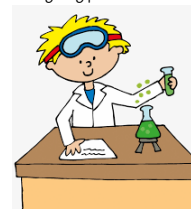
Mathematics
