

LEARNING LOST DUE TO BEING CONSISTENTLY LATE



Our doors open at 8.45 am, and the register is taken at 8.55 am. The register closes at 9.25 am.

If your child arrives between 8.55 am and 9.25 am, they will be marked as 'Late' (L). If your child arrives after 9.25 am, they will be marked with an 'Unauthorised Absence' (U) which means they are really late and do not achieve their attendance mark for the morning.

Poor punctuality can lead to your child

- Feeling embarrassed in front of their friends
- Missing the beginning of vital lessons making them fall behind
- Missing important instructions for the rest of the school day
- Learning bad habits which could affect their employability in the future

The table below shows just how much learning could be missed by being **consistently late** to school each day:

Minutes late per day	Learning time lost in 1 year
5 minutes	3 1/2 days
10 minutes	7 days
15 minutes	10 1/2 days
20 minutes	14 days
30 minutes	21 days

We know that a child's punctuality has a direct impact on their education.

Those children who are regularly late from school do not achieve their full potential - they do fall behind their peers!
