



# Traditional Tales with a Twist

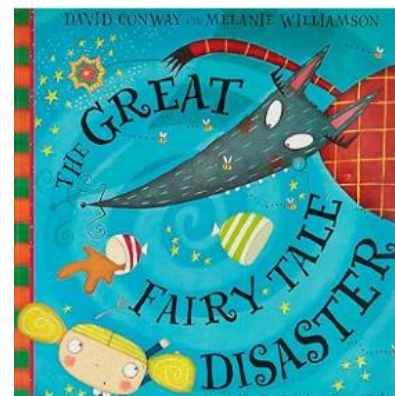


## English

This half term we will be looking the well know traditional and fairy tales, including The 3 Little Pigs, Jack and the Beanstalk and Rapunzel.

Our **Key Learning** will be:

- Secure the use of full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks and question marks.
- Say, write and punctuation sentences using *and*, *but* and *or*.
- Collect new vocabulary and key words.
- Use past tense for narratives.
- Proof read to check for errors.
- Use adjectives and noun phrases effectively
- Use subordination for time, using *when*, *before* and *after*.



We will also be looking at instructions.

. Our **Key Learning** will be:

- Use commas to separate items in a list.
- Select, generate and effectively use imperative verbs.
- Evaluate their writing with adults and peers.
- Proofread to check for errors in spelling, grammar and punctuation.

## History

In history, we will be continuing our learning about the history of our local area!

We will also be learning about the American astronaut Mae Jemison for Black History Month.



## Geography

Our topic for Geography is 'Why is our world wonderful?' We will be learning the names of the 7 continents and 5 oceans and locating them in an atlas. We will be looking at some of the key human and physical features of the UK and naming the 4 capital cities. We will also be collecting data using a tally chart.

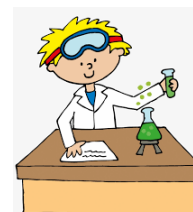
## Mathematics
