## Uniform and PE.

We currently have PE on a Monday afternoon (swimming), so the children need to come to school in their PE kit. On the other days each week, unless we are having a non-uniform day or other special event, the children need to come to schoot in uniform - as outlined in the Uniform Poticy.

We are so proud of how smart the children look around schoot and would like to thank you for supporting this.

Once we have completed the National Curriculum Swimming lessons, should there be any changes with regards to our PE day, I will inform you of this via the class email.

In the Summer of Year 4 the children will take the Government MTC (Multiplication Tables, Check).+ This is an online test, with 25 questions. The children have 6 seconds to answer per question, with a 3 second rest in between each question.

It is designed to test the children's fluency in multiplication facts and doesn't contain division questions.

We use Maths lessons to support our times tables knowledge, and TTRockstars, to improve our fluency and speed.

- In Class 4 the weekly homework consists of Reading, Times Tables, TTRockstars, Spellings and Active Learn.
- Reading: Every evening using their home reader and reading record, to be signed by parents. Please try to listen to your child at least 3 times a week (they can read independently some nights but still sign their book please).
- Times Tables: Each week your child will be given a list of times tables to practise/learn. We will have a test each Friday.
- TTRockstars: Minimum of 10 minutes per week.
- Spellings: I will give the children a short list of words to learn each week. We will not be having formal tests on these words, but I will be assessing the cnuldren's ability to apply
these words correctly as part of their English Writing
